12. Interaction and Field Visit to Lakshmi Self Help Group:18th Feb 2021

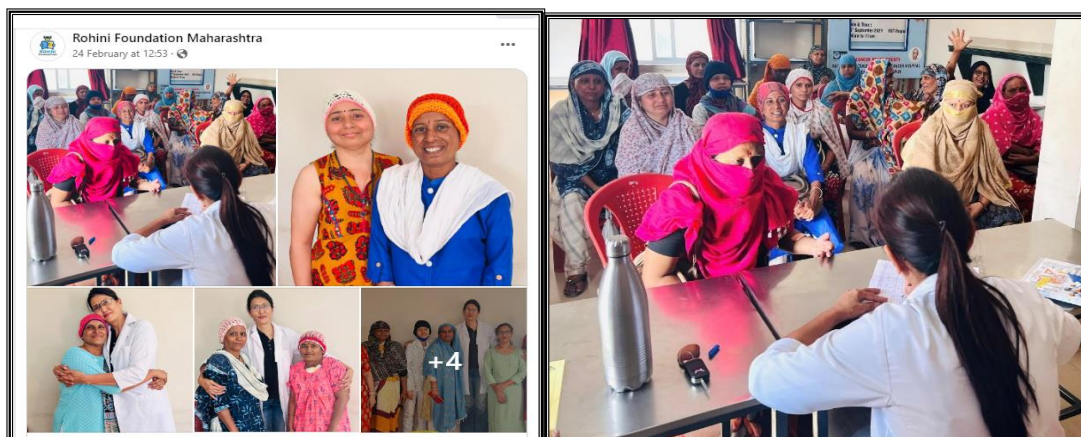

3) 52ND HISTORY CONFERENCE ON VIDHARBH LEVEL :

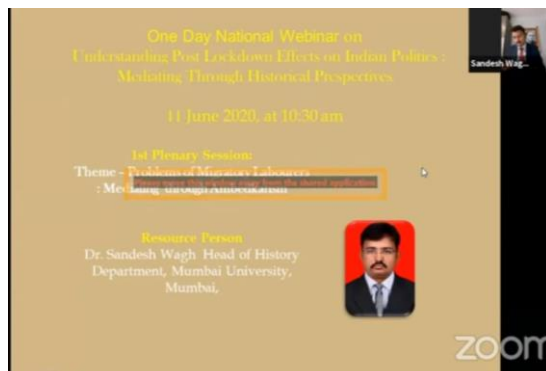

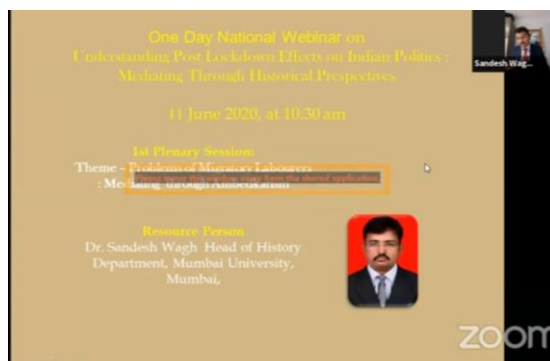

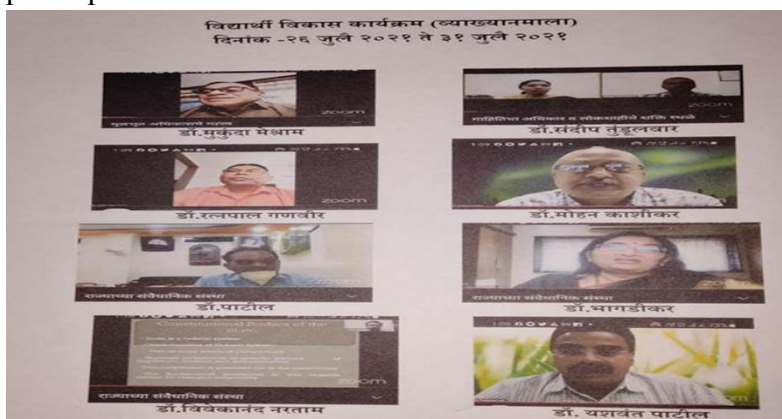
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Student Development Program and Lecture Series:-

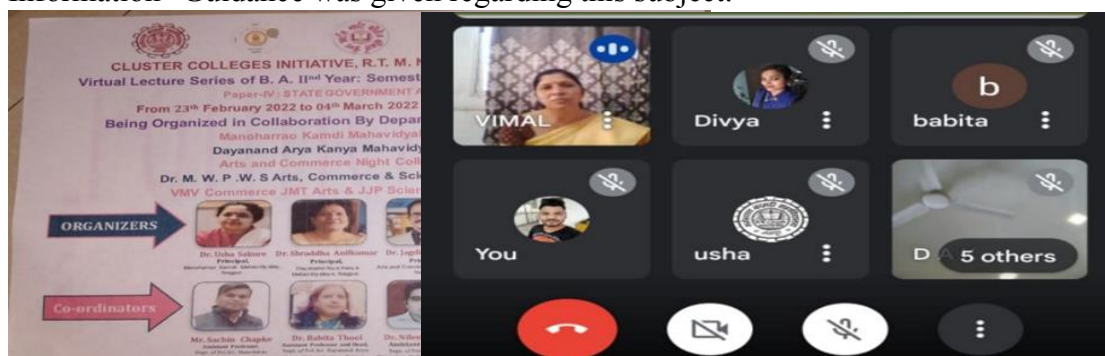
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Student Development Program and Lecture Series:-

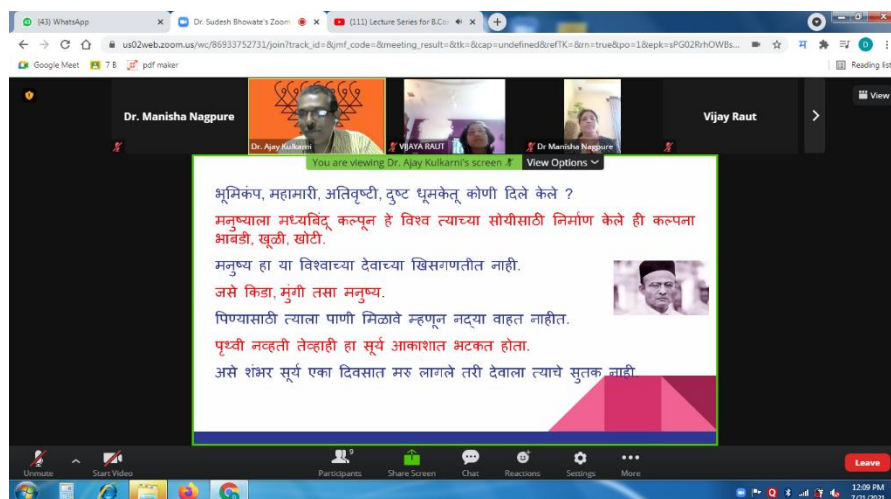

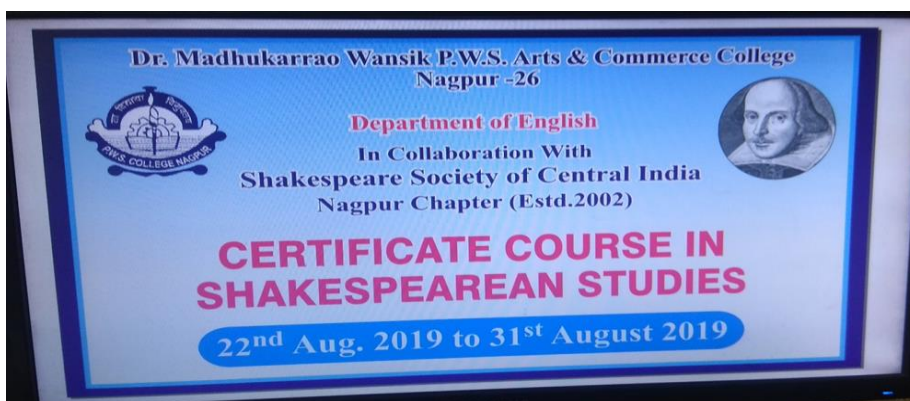
ii) Guest Lecture “The Use of Punctuation Marks”

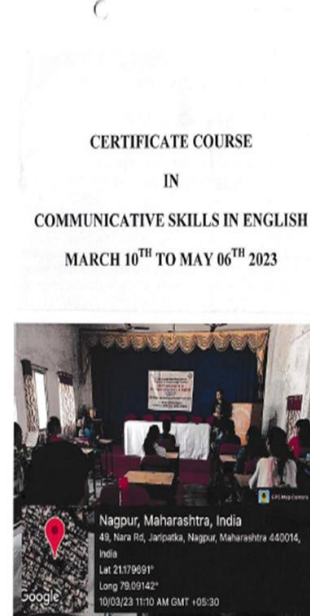
Online Lecture Series:
