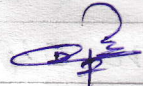
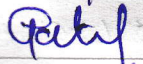
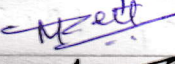

Minutes

Mr. Sudesh Bhowate, convener of the committee, welcome all the members in the meeting. He introduced the purpose of the meeting, since the third cycle of NAAC was over recently, it was necessary to gear up for the work of next cycle of NAAC. Since the anti-ragging cell was important one, as per the circular of UGC and RTM Nagpur University, Nagpur, college need to open campaign for awareness amongst the students. Dr. Bhowate appealed the members to cooperate.

members agreed to the proposal.

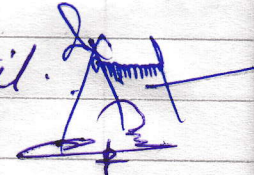
The meeting came to an

Minutes

The meeting of the Anti-ragging cell was conducted on Monday 22/01/2018 in the Hon. Principal Dr. Yeshwant Patil sir's office at 12.30 pm. Following members of the committee were present in the meeting.

The convener of the cell Mr. Sudesh Bhowate welcomed the Hon. Principal Dr. Yeshwant Patil sir and respected members of the cell. Since that was the regular meeting of the cell, Mr. Bhowate sought permission from Hon. Principal to confirm the minutes of the previous meeting to which, Hon. Principal agreed.

In the previous meeting

The first agenda was to welcome the members of the cell who were divided to work together. Dr. Bhowate informed the members that they were all welcomed with Rose in the previous meeting.

Coming to the second agenda of meeting was to circulate notices of the cell to each class and Dr. Bhowate informed the members that the notices were circulating on December 2017 in every classes. And the feedback of all the class teachers were very positive following the suggestion of Dr. Megha Rautiche, the committee members were acting as the Anti-ragging squad. Accordingly all the members took a round of campus twice in the month of December. So the minute have confirmed.

The third agenda of previous meeting was to put up flex boards in the campus. The agenda was implemented. Four sign boards were put up in the ground floor corridor as well as on first floor.

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The last subject of the previous meeting to convene the meeting in the presence of the principal. Hence the present meeting was conducted in the presence of Hon. Pravin D. Patil.

Coming to the third agenda
Mr. Bhowate drew everyone's attention
to the point that Anti-ragging sign
Boards and Rule Boards were put
up some five six years ago,
some of them are torned in state
and few are quite faded. Dr. Mitesh
Ramteke supported the stand of Mr.
Bhowate to print few new boards.
Principal sir agreed to sanction
expenses towards the printing of
Boards. Dr. Chakraborty informed the
member that he had already down-
loaded images and rules for
Anti-ragging cell. He had shown
the Xerox copies of them. All
member had gone through them
and it was decided to print
at least Two rule Boards and
three image based sign Boards.

The last agenda of the meeting

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was to discuss the subjects with
 the permission of Chair. No new
 issues were reported by the members.
 The meeting was concluded with the
 note that the next meeting will
 be conducted in the beginning of
 the next session.
