About the University

Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University formerly Nagpur University established by Government of Central Provinces Education Department in 1923. It is one of the oldest premier universities in India as well as second oldest in the state of Maharashtra. The university is accredited 'A' grade by NAAC Bangalore. It has four faculties: i.e. Science and Technology, Commerce and Management, Humanities and Interdisciplinary Studies. These have 36 departments and there are 12 other departments and centres. Almost every department has research facilities for M.Phil., Ph.D. and Post. Doc. The University has three national repute Constituent Colleges/Institutions (1) Dr. Ambedkar Law College (with two campuses), (2) Laxminarayan Institute of Technology, and Bar. Wankhede College of Education. The Department and conducted college/Institution buildings are spread in several campuses in and around the city. Currently about Five hundred and three colleges are affiliated to it. More than four Lakh students are enrolled under different courses in the university.

About the Dept. of Pali & Prakrit and Buddhist Studies:

The Department of Pali & Prakrit established in 1958 which is one of the prominent departments of RTM Nagpur University. The most significant fact of this department is that it was established after the great conversion into Buddhism by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar in 1956 at Nagpur *Deekshabhoomi* along with his millions of followers. Nagpur University took initiatives and started the department for higher studies in Pali and Buddhism. The department runs M.A, M.Phil. and Ph. D. Courses . Every year many foreign students and research scholars from Buddhist Countries take admission in the department. With the growing interest of students in Buddhism, Department initiated M.A. in Buddhist Studies from the year 2011-12. Shortly M.Phil.and Ph.D. Courses in Buddhist studies were introduced.

About Dr. Madhukarrao Wasnik PWS Arts and Commerce College, Nagpur:

The college is one of the oldest institutions in Nagpur established in 1968 situated on Kamptee Road. Under the guidance of its founder and chairman of People's Welfare Society Dr. Madhukarraoji Wasnik ex-MLC, the institution has grown up into a multi facultuy college with the streangth of over 4000 students and catering to the higher educational needs of the weaker sections of the region where college is situated. The institution offers comprehensive range of under graduate and post graduate degree courses and research facilities. The institution has already undergone three cycles of accreditation. Pali and Dr. Ambedkar thoughts are the popular subjects in the college with oldest research centre for Doctoral and Post-doctoral research.

About the Theme of the Webinar:

Pali is one of the ancient languages i.e. contemporary Lingua-Franca in India. Teachings of Buddha are preserved in this language which is treated as the messenger of Indian culture and Buddha Dhamma. Therefore, Pali is the original source to reach out for essential and complete information about Indian history, culture, philosophy, geography, socio-political, economical and religious conditions, values, customs, traditions, popular literature and educational system, etc. This tradition of the culture later was fostered for oncoming centuries by many contemporary ancient Indian universities like, Taxila, Nalanda, Oduntapuri, Vallbhi, Jagdal, Nagarjunkonda, Lalitgiri, Sarnath, Sanchi, etc. As a matter of fact ancient languages and Indian archeology has a close relation which needs to be studied by the scholars.

Buddha unveiled his teachings in 6th century BC for the welfare of people. Since it was widely accepted it helped popularizing and spreading the Buddha Dhamma all over the country. Emperor Ashoka who embraced Buddhism spread Buddha Dhamma at each corners of the country as well as in abroad. Also to make this Dhamma long lasting he had built 84 thousands of Buddhist Stupas, rock edicts and rock pillars with Buddhist images and symbols. This was the beginning of Buddhist art and architecture helps develop various facets of Buddhist cultural art. The Buddhist art was continued progressing with the later kings who were supporter of Buddhism. Till the 12th-13th centuries Buddhist sculpture, architecture, cave art, paintings and writings have been developed. Essentially, the references to all these Buddhist art forms are found in Pali literature abundantly established a relationship between these two. The cultural heritage in the form of Buddhist art has been preserved by Archeology survey of India. However, the relationship between Pali and Indian art and Archeology need to be introduced to the present day scholars of Buddhism, Pali Language and Archeology. With this objective the present two day national webinar on "Pali Language and Buddhist Archeology" is organized.
