About the Workshop

The scholars start research in Social science, Languages or in Commerce often find research methodology a rather amorphous subject in the beginning. There is an extensive literature available but the variety of strategies, approaches; methods, terminologies and techniques, and the absence of a standard nomenclature present a daunting task for a first researcher. In this workshop, the aim is firstly to provide a brief overview of the principal terminology likely to be encountered in research literature. We shall try to stress on those aspects which are the most important in carrying out research projects smoothly. The second aim is to present a simple model of research methodology that this model will provide not only a useful structure for the remainder of the workshop but also a readily grasped perspectives of research methodology. The third aim is to emphasize the importance of the methodology of handling research data, a topic often given little attention in workshops on research methods.

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP

- 1. To orient the Research Scholars about significance of Social Science Research
- 2. To familiarize them with philosophical and theoretical dimensions of social science in general and research in particular.
- 3. To Orient the scholars with different types of data sources and ways and means of accessing them.
- 4. To deliberate on the aspects of searching research theme, formulating research questions and objectives, setting research design and other components of research proposal.
- 5. To orient them with various research methods and techniques of data collection and data-analysis and interpretation.
- 6. To orient them with popular stylesheets (MLA/APA, etc) used in research writing
- 7. To deliberate on bestowing final shape of research output in the form of research report/thesis/monograph.
