Human being possess both the elements i.e. virtues and wicked tendencies. Being a social one he has to cultivate his virtues and through earning merits to reach Nibbana. The Buddhist ideals basically are means to practice and to follow. The virtues and moral strengths which make him more possible to reach the goal of Arhantship are to possess the elements of *Brahmavihara* through meditational practices. Brahmavihara means "four states of dwelling" are the four state of mind. The four virtues of *Brahmavihara* are Metta (loving Kindness), Karuna (Compassion), Mudita (Sympathetic Joy) and Upekkha (Equanimity). They are also called as *appamana* (illimitable) because, they are limitless and could be extended towards all being.

The practice of *"Brahmavihara*" helps the practitioner remove the mental defilements and develops in him immense love for all living and non-living beings. Human being possesses destructive elements like anger, cruelty, and jealousy and besides these he has other negative elements like desires and attachments. As per Narada Thera, these virtues (*Brahmavihara*) tend to elevate man. They make one divine in this life itself. They can transform man into superman. If all try to cultivate them, irrespective of creed, colour, race, or sex, the earth can be transformed into paradise where all can live in perfect peace and harmony as ideal citizen of one world"

The present day world is divided into boundaries of countries, religion, sects and gripped with so much orthodoxy in such a way that they lost tolerance for persons and practices from other sections. The hatred for the fellow human beings in the name of caste and race or colour is something against the nature of human being as we called ourselves civilized.
